#### Main entrance

Building A, A.C. Meyers Vænge 15.


### **Opening hours**

Our buildings are open **Monday - Thursday: 7.30-15.30. Friday: 7.30-15.00.** However, the revolving door by the main entrance is open **Monday - Friday: 7.00-17.00.** 

Outside opening hours, the buildings are only accessible with an active AAUcard.

### SERVICES

### The Information Desk

At the information desk, you can get help with navigating around campus, receiving visitors, guest parking, and much more.

The information desk is located by the main entrance of building A. **Opening hours: Monday-Thursday: 8.15-15.30. Friday: 8.15-15.00.** 

### **IT Services CPH**

At IT Services, students and employees can get help and guidance on digitalisation and IT services.

The IT service desk is located in building A on the fifth floor, near the rotunda. **Opening hours: Monday-Thursday: 8.00-15.30. Friday: 8.00-15.00.** 

Employees and students can also create a case and chat with support staff on **serviceportal.aau.dk**.

### The Library (AUB)

The library offers study spaces and facilities, helpful staff, and an active study collection that you can use on site. The library is located in building A on the second floor, near the rotunda.

### Opening hours: Monday-Thursday: 9.00-14.30. Friday: 9.00-14.00.

Outside opening hours, you can access the library 24/7 with an activated AAUcard.

### **Facility Support CPH**

Facility Support CPH activates AAUcards, hands out keys, handles mail, and much more. The facility support desk is located in building A, ground floor, room 0.093.

### Opening hours: Monday-Thursday: 8.00-14.30. Friday: 8.00-14.00.

Students and employees can report various errors and deficiencies at campus in the app AAU Building Support. You can download the app in App Store or Google Play Store.

### AAUCARD

The AAUcard functions as an access card to buildings and as an ID card when you move around the university's premises.

#### Ordering your card

Students obtain an AAUcard by uploading their photo in the self-service system UniStart. You obtain login information to UniStart once you have been admitted.


Employees should contact Facility Support to get their photo taken and order their card.

### Picking up your card

You will receive an email when your AAUcard is ready to be picked up. You can pick up your card at the Facility Support desk in building A, ground floor, 0.093.

### **PRINT & COPY**

#### Printing on campus

There are many printers and copy machines available for students and employees on campus. You can print via the Follow-You function where you send your document to the 'cloud' instead of a specific printer, and you can then go to any printer on campus and print your documents using your AAUcard.

Most printers are available for use by students although some are reserved for staff. Staff printers are marked as such either on or by the printer.

### Pricing

All students receive 100 print units for free when they start at AAU, which is equivalent to 250 pages printed in colour. If you need to print more, you can buy more print units online. 100 units cost DKK 125.-

### STUDENT AREAS



#### Student Lounge

In the Student Lounge, you can relax in the soft sofas, watch movies, play board games, or work on your projects. You'll find the student lounge on the ground floor of building A, in room 0.0.1A.



### The Student Square / Studentertorvet

The Student Square has tables, couches, and bean bags where you can study, eat your lunch, or just relax. It is also where you'll find *The Coffee Spot (Kaffepletten)*, our student café that serves coffee and cake at student friendly prices a few afternoons a week.



### **Contemplation room**

The contemplation room is a room to meditate, contemplate, or reflect. Find the contemplation room in building A on the third floor by the rotunda in room 3.058.



### The Mirror Room / Spejlsalen

In the Mirror Room, you'll find table tennis, table football, couches, music center, and more. Find the room on the ground floor in building A in room 0.042.



### Waterfront

Take advantage of the location of campus and install yourself by the beautiful waterfront. Here you can eat your lunch, drink a coffee in the afternoon, or just hang out.

### STUDENT GUIDANCE

You can find our student guidance office on the ground floor in building B, right by the small canteen.

To get there, turn right at the information desk at the main entrance, cross the bridge, and take the stairs or elevator one floor down.



### **Big canteen**

The big canteen in building A serves a variety of snacks and meals based on organic, seasonal ingredients.

### **Opening hours:**

Breakfast	7.30-10.30
Lunch (Mon-Thurs)	11.00-14.00
Lunch (Friday)	11.00-13.30



#### Small canteen

In the small canteen in building B, you can buy pizza, sandwiches, and salads during lunch.

### **Opening hours:**

Breakfast	Closed
Lunch (Mon-Thurs)	11.00-14.00
Lunch (Friday)	11.00-13.30



### Self-service smart fridges

You can use your payment card to buy ready meals and drinks from the self-service smart fridges at all hours. They are located right next to the big canteen in building A.



### Coffee

You can buy coffee in our canteens and from the coffee machine in the rotunda. Employees can also get their coffee in the vending machines in the kitchens by using their AAUcard.



#### Kitchens

Around campus, you will find small kitchens for use by students, employees, and guests.



### Cold water taps

There are specific cold water taps installed in the canteens and kitchens on campus so you can enjoy ice cold water without keeping the water running.

### **FITNESS & SAUNA**

### Fitness

The campus' fitness centre is located on the ground floor of building A in room 0.067. Here, you can do cardio and strenght based workouts. The fitness centre is open 24 hours a day and is unstaffed.


To get there, take the elevator marked 'fitness' from the rotunda to the ground floor, then turn right. You can also use the stairs or the elevator located at the back of the canteen area.

### **GREEN & CLEAN CAMPUS**

There are many things you can do to help keep our campus green and clean while making sustainability a natural part of your life at campus, such as:

### 1. Waste sorting

Waste sorting is an important part of daily life on campus. By sorting your waste correctly, it is possible for AAU to send waste for recycling.


### 2. Limit use of disposable cups

AAU CPH is limiting the use of disposable cups at campus. Bring your own cup to our coffee machines or when you buy coffee in the canteen (and get a discount!).

### 3. Bring back used tableware and cutlery to the canteen

Help keep campus tidy by bringing back the canteens' plates, mugs, and cutlery after use. The return area is located right next to the canteen itself.

### WASTE SORTING GUIDE



Plastic, bio, and general waste

Sort plastic, bio/food waste, and general waste in the centrally located waste bins.



### Paper and smaller cardboard items

Sort paper and smaller cardboard items in the paper bins located by the AAU printers.



## Other and hazardous waste

Sort all other waste (e.i. boxes, glass, metal, and hazardous waste) in the recycling rooms.\*

 $^{*}$ The recycling rooms are located in building A on the ground floor, and outside between building B and C.

#### Cars

Cars can be parked **one hour** for free on the campus parking spaces without a parking license.

Contact the Information Desk to get day licences and Facility Support to get period licences for parking.


#### **Electric cars**

AAU CPH has 10 parking spaces where you can charge your electric car with chargers from Clever. These parking spaces require a parking permit.

### Bikes

AAU CPH has both smaller and larger parking areas around campus for regular bikes, electric bikes, and scooters.

There is also a small bike repair place on campus where you have access to oil, water, and an air pump. If you turn left at the bottom of the main entrance stairs and continue down the ramp, you will find the repair place underneath the main entrance stairs.



### GOING TO/FROM CAMPUS

### Train 😏


The S-train station *Sydhavn Station* is located a short walk from campus. From there, you can take the S-train lines A and E.

### Metro 🖊

The M4 metro stations *Sluseholmen* and *Mozarts Plads* are within walking distance of campus. From there, you can reach the central station and *Rådhuspladsen* in less than 10 minutes.

### Bus 8A 17 19 23 97N

The bus lines 8A, 17, 19, 23, and 97N all have stops close to campus.
