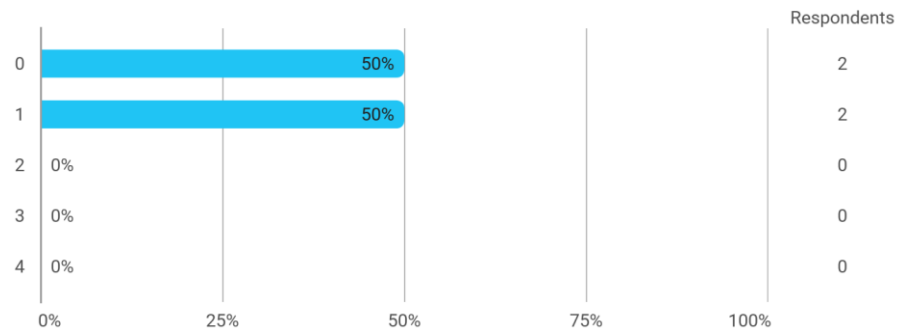

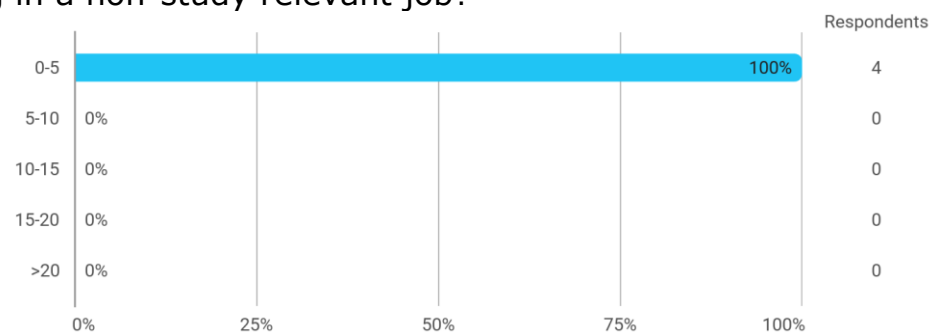
14. How many hours have you on average been studying per week?



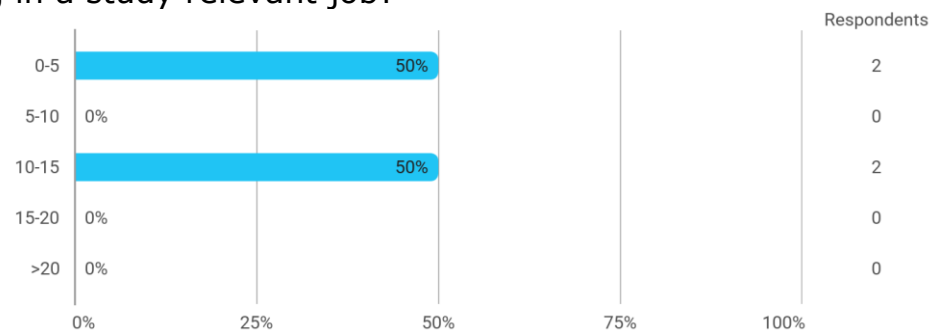
15. How many semester projects have you been doing in collaboration with external partners?



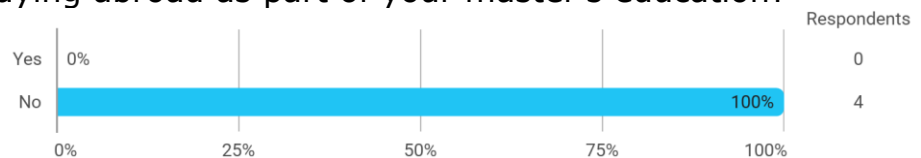
16. During your masters's programme, how many hours a week have you on average been working in a non-study relevant job?



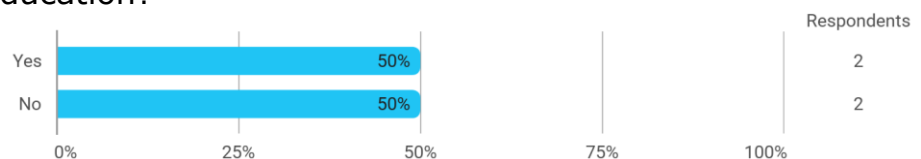
