1. Semester Structure and Planning

 Make it clear to the students that the academic staff, through their professional contacts, can assist in finding a company for a project-based course.

Follow-up: At the orientation meeting in the second semester of the Master's programme in spring, the head of the study board informs the students that they are welcome to contact lecturers, supervisors, and semester coordinators to get recommendations for companies in connection with a project-based course in a company. The semester coordinator for the third semester of the Master's programme receives a copy of the agreements that are made.
