## The public conclusions and recommendations of the semester coordinator

SSD8 2025 progressed smoothly. The students provided a positive assessment of the way in which the semester was coordinated and communicated. The workshop-based format was considered fun and engaging and helped the students develop their skills and confidence.

Things to remember and consider for the next edition of SSD8 are:


- We need to double-check that granular information about the schedule is provided in Moodle
- For the course 'Perspectives in Service Design', some students suggested that the course could look more closely into behavioral design and working with data. In addition, the students would ideally prefer the exams to follow a group-based order
- For the course 'User Participation and Social Innovation', some students suggesting tweaking the format and timing of the workshops, making sure that they are connected by a red thread In general, it is also good practice to remember that online lectures are less effective than in-person ones. If online lectures cannot be avoided, adequate formats should be considered (e.g., shorter sessions, more frequent breaks). In terms of logistics, throughout the semester, the students repeatedly asked to have a garbage bin for the paper in their room, but nothing happened

## Conclusion of the study board


The Study Board (MSN) has processed the semester evaluation report and offers the following observations/conclusions:

- Grade statistics are fine.



- My ability to identify and formulate problems




