You must apply for your EU residence document online at the Danish Agency for International Recruitment and Integration (SIRI) in advance. We strongly advise you to book a meeting with SIRI on their special opening days for EU students where your EU document **is issued on the same day (while you wait)**. Make sure to book your meeting well in advance as available spots will fill up fast.
