Seoul National University(SNU) Hosts 2025 NLC Node Events

For the first time in its history, the Networked Learning Consortium (NLC) is coming to Seoul, South Korea!

Building on the great success of the 2021 NLC node event, hNL21—a research workshop explored the methodological possibilities of “phenomenology” for NL research—at this upcoming 2025 NLC node event in Asia, NLC will continue the methodological imaginations in the post-era. This Seoul-based gathering marks a new milestone in the NLC’s global outreach, connecting NL researchers around the world.







Networked Learning Research in the Post-Era

This research workshop series invites educational researchers to come together to critically and creatively explore how NL experiences are being (re-)shaped by the rapid emergence and entanglement of new philosophies, technologies, and methodologies. Each workshop will focus on pivotal conceptual turns in educational research practices—**Postphenomenology, Postdigital Science, Posthuman Theory**—as evolving tools, allowing NL researchers to collectively imagine new research possibilities. Outcomes of these workshops will be presented at the NLC 2026 in Brussels, Belgium, and further published as part of the Research in Networked Learning book series by Springer.
