Regulations for campaign material for AAU elections to governing bodies

The Rector and Pro-rector welcome the opportunity for students to campaign for their election to governing bodies at Aalborg University by displaying campaign posters and distributing campaign material.

However, it is essential that these activities take place in a respectful way that does not cause damage to walls, floors, glass, doors, etc. Therefore, candidates are required to contact Facility Support to obtain approved adhesives and instructions on where campaign material may be displayed.

The Rector and Pro-rector urge candidates to ensure they comply with section 27 of the election rules ('Candidates must run their campaign in a fair and decent way').

Distributing campaign material including campaign posters is allowed from 10 November 2026

- The prerequisite for hanging election material is a prior registration with Facility Support on e-mail facilitysupport@adm.aau.dk. The following must be enclosed: Name/student organisation, e-mail address, phone number. Registration can be done by student organisations or individuals. Alternatively, registration can be done at one of the Facility Support addresses listed below during the designated opening hours (see information below).
- Facility Support will give instructions on where materials may be hanged and distribute sticky stuff. Election material may not be hung outside the locations designated by Facility Support, and the type of sticky stuff provided must be used.
- Election campaign materials must be displayed in accordance with Facility Support's instructions regarding the designated display locations and the use of adhesive materials. The candidate or student association that has registered the display is responsible for ensuring that the materials are posted correctly. In the event of non-compliant posting, Facility Support will contact the registered candidate or student association to ensure that the materials are immediately brought into compliance with the rules or removed.

No later than Friday 4 December 2026 at 14:00:

- All campaign material must be removed and taken down
- If the material is not taken down, the University will send a bill (cleaning fee).
