#### Status of curriculum revision

The revisions for the educations in Esbjerg and the chemistry educations in Aalborg are approved.

LHP: The digital learning objectives must be revised by LHP for Esbjerg

Bachelor of engineering programs (diplomingeniøruddannelser) are to be shortened by one month.

LHP: The Vice Dean for Education has informed us that the Bachelor of Engineering programs must be shortened by one month.

This means that students will be required to work during August in their 7th semester in order to complete their exams before Christmas.

We do not yet know when this change will be implemented and are therefore awaiting further information from the Vice Dean.
