1. Semester Structure and Planning

Improved academic and social integration of international students is requested

Follow-up: The Study Board is establishing a social committee to organize social activities at the beginning of the first semester of the Master's programme.

Several students comment that statistics is irrelevant for this specialization.

Follow-up: Statistics is a big part of the study programme i.e. in the projects and the Power System-course. The study board will ask the teachers to show more examples of the practical use of the course.

2. Project

• Suggestion to better prepare AAU bachelor's students for collaborating with international students on a PBL project.

Follow-up: It is the supervisor who should be prepared for the challenges – not our bachelor's students. We have a rule that a group may include up to two Danish students, in accordance with the group formation guidelines.

3. Courses
