



## Conclusion of the study board

The study board has on its meeting on the above data decided that no actions are required from the Study Board.

In the evaluation the students point out the education lives up to their expectations, however it is not always clear how a mixture of technical and "soft" subjects contributes to the education's profile. Some students express a wish for more programming classes. However, the coherence of the program is accessed by the students as good.

The number of study hours per week reported by the students are very different (ranging from 25-30 to more than 50 hours).
