

Study Board Follow-up on the Semester Evaluation F25

EN6: TE6 + ME6 + EE6

Response Rate

TE6: 40%, ME6: 100%, EE6: 56%

1. Semester Coherence and Planning

- EE6: Students expressed differing opinions regarding holding exams in April.

Follow-up: There was general satisfaction with holding the exams in April, as it allows better focus on project work. Semester coordinators are encouraged to inform students about the structure at the start of the semester. This topic will be included on the semester kick-off meeting agenda.

- TE6: Students reported feeling overlooked as diploma engineering students. They requested:
 - a clearer plan for diploma group formation,
 - higher priority in the allocation of group rooms, and
 - questionnaires that also address non-project-writing groups.

Follow-up: The Study Board suggests coordinating at semester start to ensure that diploma students are assigned a dedicated room, especially when many are enrolled, while still allowing them to participate in shared exercise groups whenever possible.
